GALLERIES EXHIBIT

As noted in a previous newsletter, the club has an opportunity to present a photographic exhibit at the Huntington Galleries. The exact date will be known in September when the Galleries complete their spring scheduling. The tentative date is for sometime in January or February. A committee has been formed to oversee the judging and rules for the exhibit. The entries will be judged by a non-member panel who will be selected by the exhibit committee. The main role of the judging will be to select prints of good print quality and excellent presentation to represent our club. The composition of the print should be judged by the photographer before the print is submitted i.e. members should enter prints which convey a particular meaning or esthetic feeling which the photographer wishes to express.

Prints may be either black&white or color with any size acceptable. The Galleries prefer that they be framed but unframed prints may be shown also. The exhibit committee urges members to use neutral color mats with shades of gray preferred.

All members are urged to enter one or more prints. We will have room for about 3 to 5 prints per member- so everyone who wishes to exhibit a print will have the opportunity. Members are reminded to print some of the very excellent slides which are entered in our monthly slide contest.
