Camera Support-

Ever wish that you always used a tripod but resented packing the big bulky monster around for a whole day. The answer may be an invention by a fellow PSA'er, John Schmidt, of Englewood, Fla. The invention called a "Pho Go Stick" resembles a modified monopod. The instrument consists of a metal pole 36 inches long and 13oz in weight, and can be extended to 72 inches by a simple twist of the rubber crutch tip at the bottom. The camera platform unit has a wooden handle with a hole, and this hole slips over the pole. The platform screws into the wooden handle and provides firm support for the camera. The handle has a brake device so that the entire unit can slide along the pole quickly and smoothly to position the camera. The platform swings to allow both horizontal and vertical positioning. The price will be \$49.95 but a limited number are available for \$39.95. Order from Cottage Industries of Englewood, 1634 Overbrook Road, Englewood, FLA 33533.

Kodak Ektachrome 100-

A new color slide film has been introduced of Kodak. This new film should have improved reproduction of flesh tones and neutrals with shadow areas appearing more neutral and less blue than with Ektachrome 64. This new film more faithfully reproduced certain problem fabrics and plants that has been difficult to photograph in the past. This film is E-6 processing and is balanced for daylight or electronic flash.
